Betty Buergler

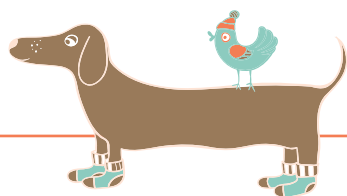

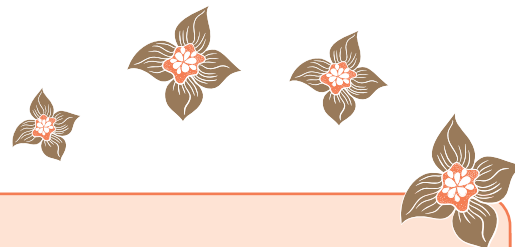

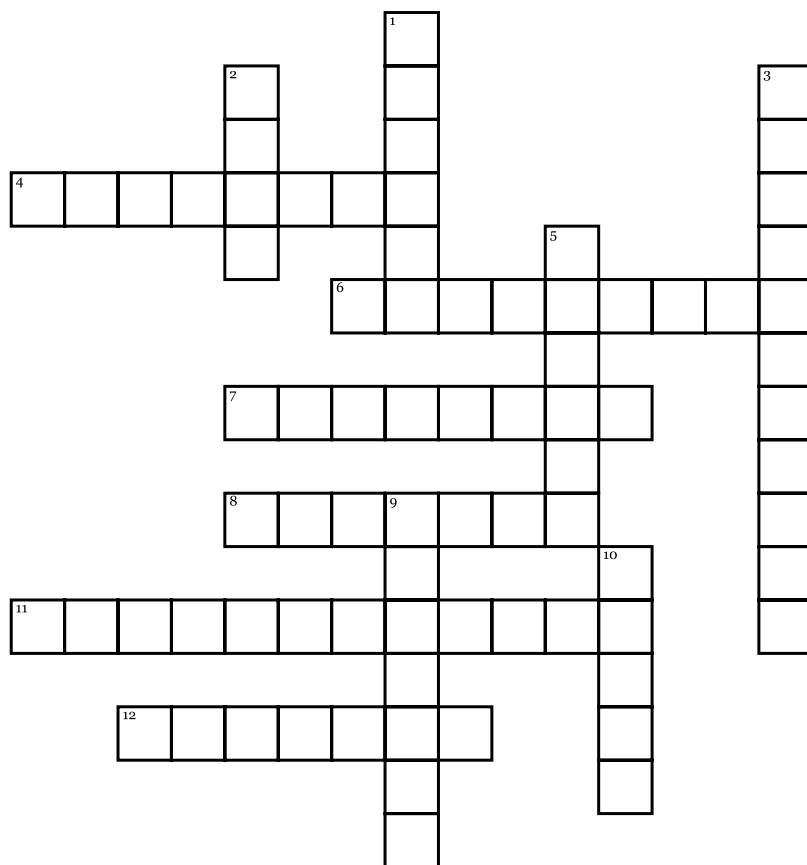

Don Rosebrugh

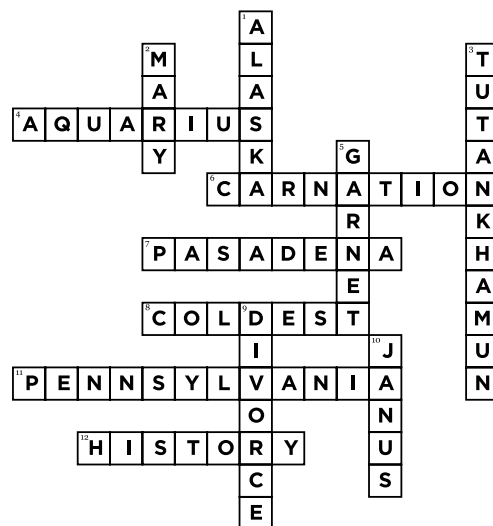
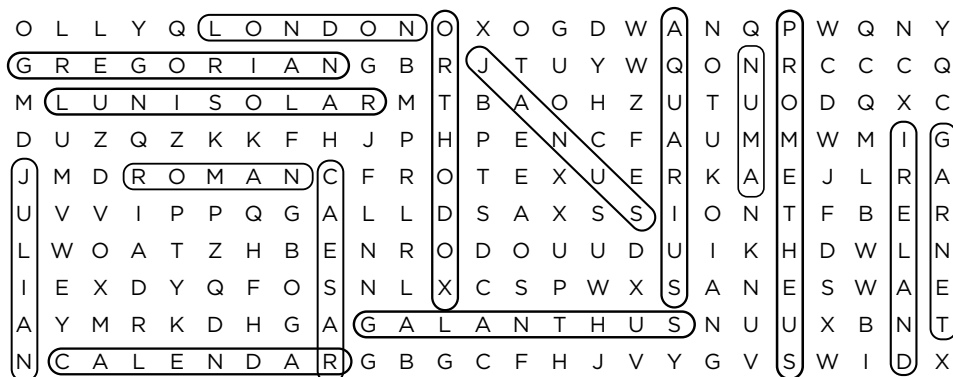
