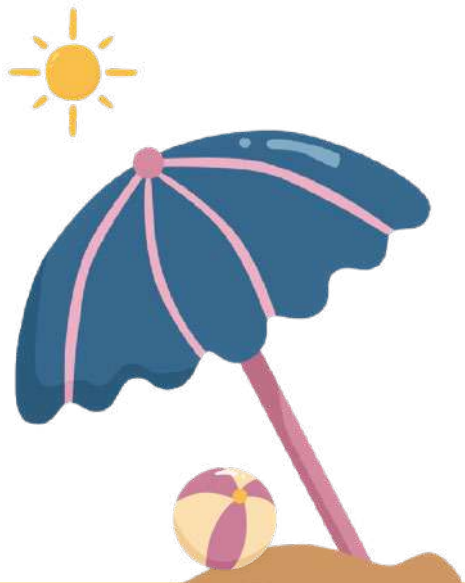

### FUN FACTS

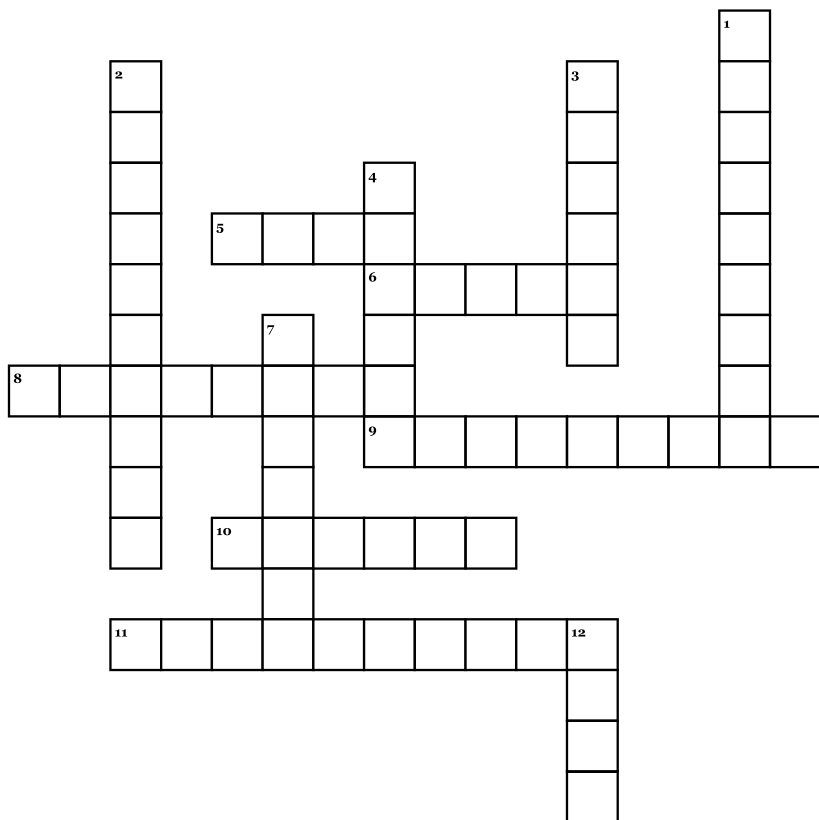
- » June is accordion awareness month.
- » June 19th is Juneteenth (also known as Freedom Day or Emancipation Day). On this day in 1865, Union General Gordon Granger read the Emancipation Proclamation aloud in Galveston, Texas, effectively liberating slaves in the state.
- » National Yo-Yo Day is June 6th.
- » June's full Moon, the full Strawberry Moon, occurs on Saturday, June 3rd. In the evening—just after sunset—look towards the southeast to watch the full Moon rise gently above the horizon.
- » The Young Men's Christian Association (YMCA) was founded in London on June 6, 1844.
- » America's first drive-in opened near Camden, New Jersey, on June 6, 1933.
- » On June 30, 1859, Jean-Francois Gravelet, known as Emile Blondin, became the first daredevil to walk across Niagara Falls on a tightrope.
- » US Route 66 was officially removed from the United States Highway System on June 27, 1985.
- » On June 14, 1959, Disneyland Monorail System, the first daily operating monorail system in the Western Hemisphere, opened to the public.
- » Sound movies were patented (#823,022) by John Ballance on June 12, 1906.
- » On June 12, 1913, John Randolph Bray exhibited the first animated cartoon, a movie called *The Artist's Dream* (aka The Dachshund) in which a dog ate sausages until he exploded.

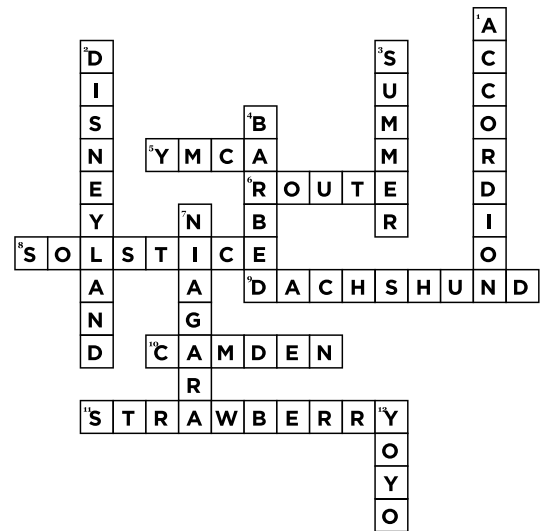
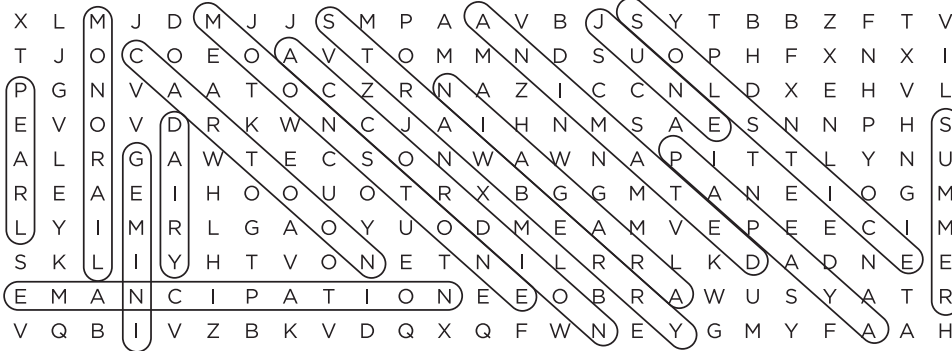
**Donna Beatty**
